Reading, Writing, Maths (RWM) combined measure:

- **2018** was **74%**
- 2017 was 69%
- 2016 was 52%

**Our target for 2019 is 80%**

# What are our priorities in 2018-19?

1. To improve the quality of teaching and learning in mathematics in order to improve progress and attainment in mathematics so that progress is at least in line with national average in 2019
2. To develop a *Growth Mindset* approach with the children
3. To improve the quality of teaching and learning in RE so that the school can aspire to an 'Outstanding' judgement in the new SIAMS framework
4. To ensure progress of all children is in line with national levels
5. To enhance quality of interventions in Years 4,5 & 6 for SEND children to improve outcomes at end of KS2
