Reading – 76% (exp) vs 78% LBN Writing - 86% (exp) vs 76% LBN Maths - 83% (exp) vs 82% LBN


Reading, Writing, Maths (RWM) combined measure at expected standard at end of Y6: 66% vs National Average of 59% & LBN 67%
