

# Making your iPad Kid-friendly

## Turning on restrictions on I pads


Go onto **Ip**ad settings




Go to **General**

Then **Restrictions**

Tap and add a password



**Note: do not share password with children if you want to have a bit more control with ipad usage. Once iPad turns off, this password will be needed to unlock it. Do not use a password that is memorable to whole family eg: 1111 or a birthday or 0000 etc.**



## Changing password

Go to [Settings](#)

Tap on [General](#)

Then [Password - enter password](#)

Pop-up - [enter new password](#) when prompted

Note: tap on required password at this point and change to immediately. This will require the iPad to seek password whenever iPad logs out.

Disabling App Store - This will stop children downloading apps without adult permission

Go to [Settings](#)

Tap on [iTunes and Apple ID](#)

Tap on [Apple ID](#)

Then [Sign out](#) when prompted.

## Turning off in-app purchases

Go onto [Ipad settings](#)

Go to [General](#)

Then [Restrictions](#) enter password. Enable restrictions if you haven't.

[In-App Purchases](#) - click on the green button once to turn white.
