

Over the next few months we are going to have to make significant savings to survive. This means we will have to think creatively to ensure that our core job of helping the children develop remains at the top of all our planning but some of the things we have provided in the past are having to be ended and some of this involves the learning platforms we provide to help the children boost their learning. We will not be renewing the Mathletics and Reading Eggs logins after Easter but we will continue to provide access to Mathseeds for our youngest children. We have not taken this decision lightly but will have to take a targeted approach from now on rather than a more universal one – apologies.

Times of School Day

Breakfast Club runs from 7.30am-8.40am and is for pupils from YR-Y6 – enter through the main school entrance on Ruscoe Rd.

Nursery 9am - 3pm – enter via Nursery Gate on Ruscoe Rd. – Gate opens at 8.30 am and 2.45pm

Reception - 8.40am - 3.15pm - enter via Nursery Gate on Ruscoe Rd. – Gate opens before the start of the day & collect from the Reception Gate at the main entrance – gate opens at 3pm

Year 1 & Year2 8.40am – 3.15pm enter via the main gate on Ruscoe Rd. and go through the gate on your left into the playground – If there is an adult on the gate you can send in the Y172's from the playground gate

Years 3,4,5&6 - 8.40am – 3.15pm enter via the back gate on Tarling Rd. into the playground
After School Clubs run Mon-Fri 3.15pm - 5pm for Y1-Y6


